


MyBucks: Bucks County Community College's Student Portal


MyBucks is the central area where college related information is located. Additionally, the portal provides access to the various college systems such as Web Advisor, Canvas, Live@Edu email, Gmail, announcements and a lot more. The following information will help you become familiar with MyBucks.

1. To log into MyBucks, type in the following URL at your preferred browser such as Internet Explorer or Mozilla Firefox – <http://my.bucks.edu>.
2. Once the MyBucks URL has been entered, you will need to log in. Enter the username and password that you use to log the college computers. When logging in from home using Internet Explorer, you will have to login with “@securebucks.edu” after your username. For example, smithj9025@securebucks.edu

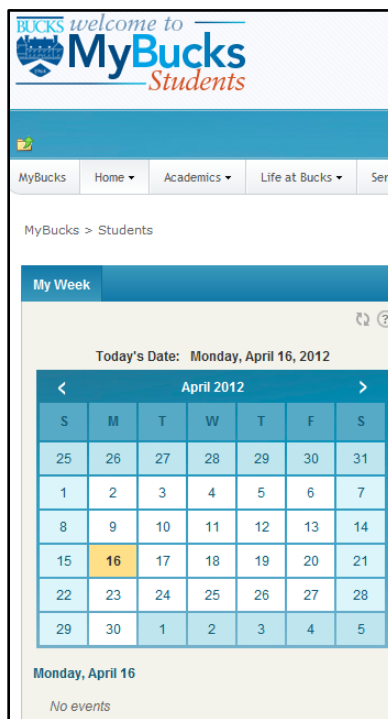

The MyBucks Interface

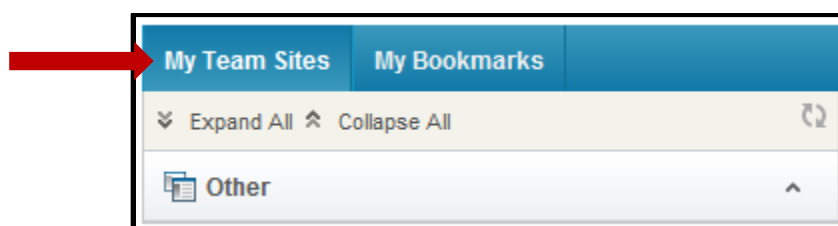
MyBucks portal is made up of three areas: 1) on the left, the personal **Calendar** located under the **My Week** section, which includes a class schedule, **My Team Sites**, **My Bookmarks** and **IT Support**, 2) access to **Live@Edu email**, **Gmail**, **Announcements**, **Campus News**, **Campus Events**, and **My Feeds** located in the middle, and 3) located on the right is access to the **Web Advisor** and **Apps for Students** tabs which provides access to Canvas, Course Compass, HelpStar trouble reporting and Web Advisor.

The Calendar and My To Do List

The Calendar located on the left section of the window will display three days of appointments from the selected date in the calendar. For example, as shown below, the actual date is August 24, but the appointments displayed are from August 24 through August 26. If there are no scheduled events for a particular day, the date will display *No events*.




The **My Team Sites** tab is the area where workspaces reside. Students will see only the areas that they share with others in the college, for example, if the student belonged to a club or organization. To view all options in the **My Team Sites** drop down menu, click on the (+) plus sign to the left of **Expand All**. The **My Bookmarks** area is where favorite internet bookmarks are stored and can be accessed.












Email, My Notifications, Announcements, Campus News, Campus Events, and My Feeds

The middle section of the portal displays email information, the current local weather, official college announcements and events. Additionally, this area will display targeted announcements such as a school closing due to inclement weather. Finally, if there are unread email messages, the student will be able to click the link to open and read the email messages.



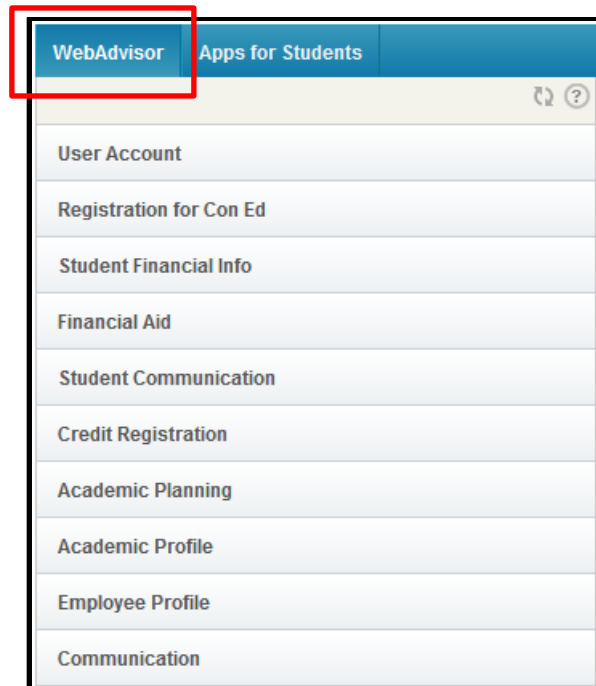

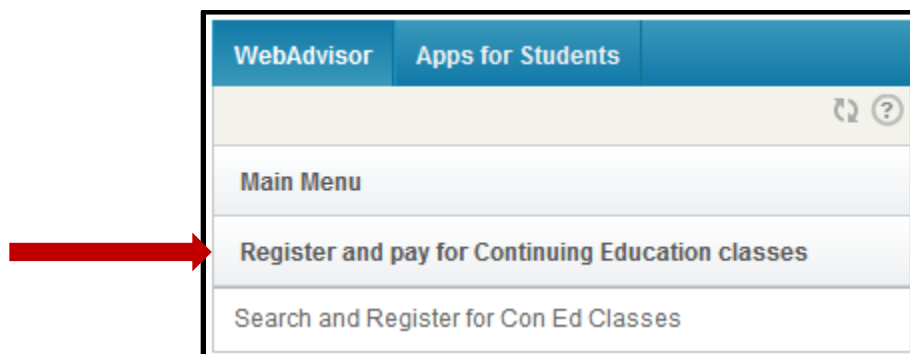

The **WebAdvisor** tab provides all of the modules that students have access to such as financial aid information, academic planning, academic profile and credit registration.

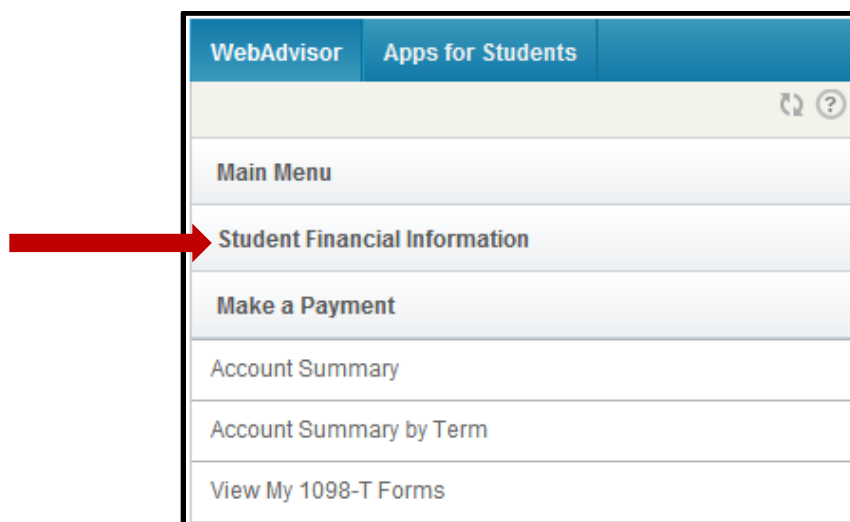
Within the **User Account** drop down menu, information on the student ID, password and change of address are available.



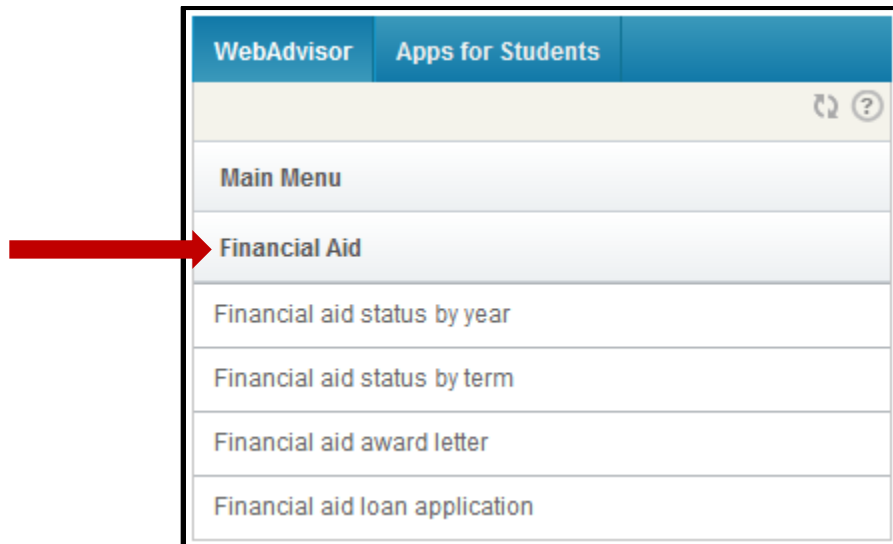
Under the **Registration for Con Ed** link students can search, register and pay for Continuing Education classes which are non-credit.



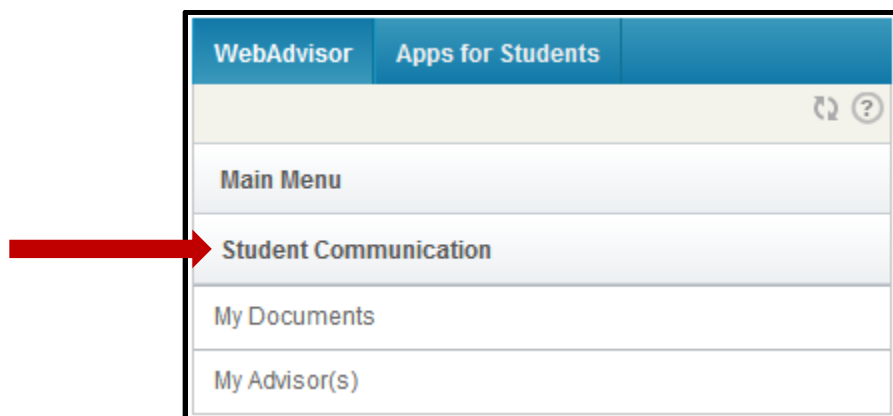
The **Student Financial Information** drop down menu provides the option to **Make a Payment** and check the status of the student **Account Summary**, **Account Summary by Term**, **View My Payment Plan Schedule**, and **View My 1098-T Forms**.



The **Financial Aid** drop down menu provides information on **Financial aid status by year**, **Financial aid status by term** or **Financial aid award letter**. These links provide pertinent information that will help in planning the cost and expected refunds available to students.



Student Communication link has information that the student will need for registration, such as a student advising registration form and waivers for course prerequisites.



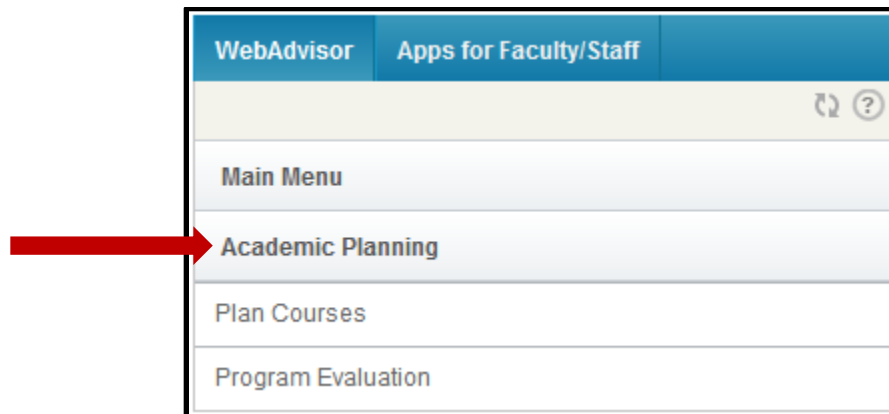
Student advising registration form
